- I bless your relationships; may others treat you well and not evil all the days of your life.
- I bless you to be sensitive to God's leading and networking to find and cultivate the people who should share your destiny.
- I bless your surroundings that you should be strategically placed.
- I bless your destiny; it will be fulfilled, and each step will be guided by the Lord.
- I bless the work of your hands; you will not fail, and all of your needs will be supplied.
- I bless every day with fruitfulness; I speak increase to all of your accomplishments.
- I bless every day with the presence of the Lord, His wisdom, and His guidance.
