Pray the Scriptures for Healing

One of the best ways to start a prayer ministry or to pray for one's own healing is to pray the Scripture. Below are excellent Scriptures to build faith, recognize God's intent to heal, and petition the Father to do what He says He will do. These Scriptures work, and many have been healed by declaring them and praying them aloud. Start using them today. Make extra copies of these pages for your Bible, car, purse, briefcase; take to the hospital, work, church, etc.

- **Psalms 103:1-5:** "Bless the Lord, O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name! Bless the Lord, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases, Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with loving kindness and tender mercies, Who satisfies your mouth with good things, So that your youth is renewed like the eagle's" (NKJV).
- James 5:13-16: "Is anyone among you suffering? Let him pray. Is anyone cheerful? Let him sing psalms. Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven. Confess your trespasses to one another, and pray for one another, that you may be healed. The effective, fervent prayer of a righteous man avails much" (NKJV).
- 1 John 3:8b: "... the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil"
- Mark 11:22-26: So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God. For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says. Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them. And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses. But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses" (NKJV).
- **Matthew 8:17:** "And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities And bore our sicknesses" (NKJV).
- **1 Peter 2:24:** "Who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—<u>by whose stripes you were healed</u>" (NKJV, emphasis added).
- **Isaiah 53: 4-6:** "Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted. But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, <u>And by His stripes we are healed</u>" (NKJV, emphasis added).
- **Psalm 107:20:** "He sent His Word and healed them" (NKJV).
- **Luke 8:50** Jesus said, "Do not be afraid; only believe, and she will be made well" (NKJV).

- **Luke 10:9:** "And heal the sick... 'The kingdom of God has come near to you'" (NKJV).
- **Luke 7:20-21:** "When the men had come to Him, they said, "John the Baptist has sent us to You, saying, 'Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?'" And that very hour He cured many of infirmities, afflictions, and evil spirits; and to many blind He gave sight" (NKJV).
- **Matthew 8:7:** "And Jesus said to him, 'I will come and heal him'" (NKJV).
- **Isaiah 61:1:** "The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon Me, Because the Lord has anointed Me To preach good tidings to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives, And the opening of the prison to those who are bound" (NKJV).
- **Luke 4:18** "THE SPIRIT OF THE LORD IS UPON ME, BECAUSE HE HAS ANOINTED ME TO PREACH THE GOSPEL TO THE POOR; HE HAS SENT ME TO HEAL THE BROKENHEARTED, TO PROCLAIM LIBERTY TO THE CAPTIVES AND RECOVERY OF SIGHT TO THE BLIND. TO SET AT LIBERTY THOSE WHO ARE OPPRESSED
- **Matt 4:23:** "And Jesus was going about in all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every kind of disease and every kind of sickness among the people" (NASB).
- **Psalms 41:3:** "The Lord will strengthen him on his bed of illness; You will sustain him on his sickbed" (NKJV).

Psalms 118:17: "I shall not die, but live, And declare the works of the Lord" (NKJV).

Luke 5:17: "And the power of the Lord was present to heal them" (NKJV).

Psalms 30:2: "O Lord my God, I cried out to You, And You healed me" (NKJV).

Matthew 15:30-31: "Then great multitudes came to Him, having with them the lame, blind, mute, maimed, and many others; and they laid them down at Jesus' feet, and He healed them. So the multitude marveled when they saw the mute speaking, the maimed made whole, the lame walking, and the blind seeing; and they glorified the God of Israel" (NKJV).

Matthew 21:22: "And whatever things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive" (NKJV). **Mark 5:34:** "...your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be healed..." (NKJV).

John 14:12-14: "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father. And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask anything in My name, I will do it" (NKJV).

Act 10:38: "how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him."
